The Legal Advice and Assistance (Financial Conditions) (No. 2) Regulations 1987

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 4 and 20 of the Legal Aid Act 1974(a), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Financial Conditions) (No. 2) Regulations 1987 and shall come into force on 6th April 1987.
- 2. For the weekly sum of £54 specified in section 4(2) of the Legal Aid Act 1974(b) there shall be substituted the weekly sum of £56.
- 3. For the sums specified in Schedule 3 to the Legal Advice and Assistance Regulations (No. 2) 1980(c), there shall be substituted the following sums:-

Exceeding £56 but not exceeding £64 a week £5

Exceeding £64 but not exceeding £68 a week £11

Exceeding £68 but not exceeding £72 a week £15

Exceeding £72 but not exceeding £76 a week £20

Exceeding £76 but not exceeding £80 a week £24

Exceeding £80 but not exceeding £84 a week £28

Exceeding £84 but not exceeding £88 a week £33

Exceeding £88 but not exceeding £92 a week £37

Exceeding £92 but not exceeding £96 a week £41

Exceeding £96 but not exceeding £100 a week £46

Exceeding £100 but not exceeding £106 a week £51

Exceeding £106 but not exceeding £112 a week £58

Exceeding £112 but not exceeding £118 a week £64

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations increase from £54 to £56 a week the disposable income above which a person receiving legal advice and assistance under Part I of the Legal Aid Act 1974 is required to pay a contribution and amend the scale of contributions.
