The Drivers' Hours (Passenger and Goods Vehicles) (Exemption) (Revocation) Regulations 1987

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Drivers' Hours (Passenger and Goods Vehicles) (Exemption) (Revocation) Regulations 1987 and shall come into force on 2nd February 1987.
- 2.— The Drivers' Hours (Passenger and Goods Vehicles) (Exemption) Regulations 1987(c) are hereby revoked.
