The Amusements with Prizes (Variation
of Monetary Limits) Order 1988

In pursuance of sections 18(1)(c) and 24(2) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(1) I hereby make the following Order:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1988 and shall come into force on 18th July 1988.

(2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.

2. In section 16(3) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(2) (conditions on which the provision of amusements is permitted at certain commercial entertainments) paragraph (b) shall have effect as if, for the sum of £15 specified in that paragraph, there were substituted the sum of £20.

3. In article 2 of the Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Monetary Limits) Order 1984(3)—

(a) for the words “Paragraphs (a), (b) and (c)” there shall be substituted the words “Paragraphs (a) and (c)”; and

(b) paragraph (b) shall be omitted.
