**The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Fees)
(Scotland) Order 1988**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 18(1) and 24(2) of the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Fees) (Scotland) Order 1988 and shall come into force on 1st March 1988.

(2) This Order shall extend to Scotland only.

2. The fee payable under paragraph 18 of Schedule 3 to the Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976(b) (which relates to permits for the commercial provision of amusements with prizes) shall, instead of £8.50, be £25.

3. The Amusements with Prizes (Variation of Fees) (Scotland) Order 1982(c) is hereby revoked.
