**DATA PROTECTION**

**The Data Protection (Fees) Regulations 1988**

*Made* - - - - *31st October 1988*  
*Laid before Parliament* *18th November 1988*  
*Coming into force* - - *11th January 1989*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 6(7), 8(5), 40(7) and 41 of the Data Protection Act 1984(1) and after consultation with the Registrar and with the approval of the Treasury in accordance with the said section 40(7), I hereby make the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Data Protection (Fees) Regulations 1988 and shall come into force on 11th January 1989.
2. The Data Protection (Fees) (No. 2) Regulations 1987(2) are hereby revoked.
3. The fee payable under section 6(7) of the Data Protection Act 1984 on an application for registration and under section 8(5) of that Act on an application for the renewal of registration shall be £56.
