The Merchant Shipping (Seamen's Wages and Accounts) (Fishing Vessels) (Amendment) Regulations 1988

Made - - - - 25th November 1988

Laid before Parliament 5th December 1988

Coming into force - - 26th December 1988

The Secretary of State, after consulting with the organisations referred to in section 99(2) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1970(1), in exercise of powers conferred by section 9 of that Act and now vested in him(2), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Seamen's Wages and Accounts) (Fishing Vessels) (Amendment) Regulations 1988 and shall come into force on 26th December 1988.
- **2.** The Merchant Shipping (Seamen's Wages and Accounts) (Fishing Vessels) Regulations 1972(**3**) shall be amended by substituting, in regulation 8, in both places, "£200" for "£50".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend The Merchant Shipping (Seamen's Wages and Accounts) (Fishing Vessels) Regulations 1972 so as to increase from £50 to £200 the maximum contribution that an employer can recover from a fisherman who is in breach of his contractual obligations.
