(Wilmslow and Alderley Edge) Order 1988

*Made* - - - - 20th January 1988

*Coming into force* - - 21st January 1988

The Secretary of State for the Environment, on the application of the North West Water Authority, being statutory water undertakers<sup>(1)</sup>, and in exercise of powers conferred by sections 33 and 59(1)<sup>(2)</sup> of the Water Act 1945<sup>(3)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(4)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order :

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the North West Water Authority (Wilmslow and Alderley Edge) Order 1988 and shall come into force on the 21st January 1988.

**Repeal of local enactment**

2. Section 61 of the Stockport Corporation Water Act 1899<sup>(5)</sup> (which provides for the Corporation to soften and clarify the water supplied by them) shall cease to have effect.
