The Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) (No. 2) Order 1988

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 81A of the Solicitors Act 1974(a) and with the concurrence of the Lord Chief Justice and the Master of the Rolls, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) (No. 2) Order 1988 and shall come into force on 1st July 1988.
- (2) In this Order "commissioners for oaths" includes a solicitor exercising the powers of a commissioner for oaths under section 81 of the Solicitors Act 1974.
- 2. The following fees (inclusive of value added tax where payable) shall be charged by commissioners for oaths:—

3. The Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) Order 1988(b) is hereby revoked, save as to any fee due or payable before the coming into force of this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order replaces the Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) Order 1988 which increased the fees chargeable by commissioners for oaths and practising solicitors for taking affidavits and similar declarations from £3.00 to £3.50 and for marking exhibits from 75p to £1.00. The increased amounts include value added tax where payable.

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
