The Home Guard (Amendment) Order 1989

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS Her Majesty deems it expedient to amend the Royal Warrant of 21st December 1964⁽¹⁾, as amended⁽²⁾, and the Order of Her Majesty of 22nd December 1964⁽³⁾, as amended⁽⁴⁾, concerning pensions and other grants in respect of disablement or death due to service in the Home Guard⁽⁵⁾ and to do so by Order in Council in accordance with section 12(1) and (3) of the Social Security (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1977⁽⁶⁾:

NOW, THEREFORE, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by the said section 12(1) and (3) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Home Guard (Amendment) Order 1989 and shall come into force on 1st September 1989.

Public funds to include reference to community charge

2.—(1) The Warrant of 21st December 1964⁽⁷⁾, concerning pensions and other grants in respect of disablement or death due to service in the Home Guard, shall be amended by the inclusion in
