**The Electricity Act 1989 (Nominated
Companies) (Scotland) Order 1989**

Made - - - - 19th December 1989

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 67(1) and (2) of the Electricity Act 1989(**(1)**), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with the North of Scotland Hydro-Electric Board and the South of Scotland Electricity Board, and with the consent of the Treasury as required by section 65(4) of that Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Electricity Act 1989 (Nominated Companies) (Scotland) Order 1989.

2.—(1) The companies whose names and registered numbers appear in the Schedule to this Order are hereby nominated for the purposes of section 67(1) of the Electricity Act 1989.

(2) Of those companies, Scottish Hydro-Electric plc and Scottish Power plc are designated as the Scottish electricity companies and Scottish Nuclear Limited is designated as the Scottish nuclear company.

The first two of these companies are designated as the Scottish electricity companies and the third as the Scottish nuclear company.
