

SCHEDULE

Article 3

1. In this Schedule, “certificate” has the meaning assigned by regulation 3 of the Legal Aid (General) Regulations 1980**(1)**.

2. Notwithstanding their repeal by the Legal Aid Act 1988, the provisions of the Legal Aid Act 1974**(2)** with respect to civil legal aid and assistance by way of representation shall continue to have effect in relation to any of the following proceedings in respect of which a certificate was issued, or the giving of assistance by way of representation was approved, before 1st April 1989:–

- (a) Proceedings under section 3 of the Children and Young Persons Act 1963**(3)**;
- (b) Proceedings under sections 3, 5 and 67(2) of the Child Care Act 1980**(4)**;
- (c) Proceedings under Part 1A of the Child Care Act 1980**(5)**.
