In exercise of powers conferred by section 26(1) of the Health and Medicines Act 1988(1) I hereby make the following Order:—

Citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Health and Medicines Act 1988 (Commencement No. 3) Order 1989.
 - (2) In this Order –

"the 1977 Act" means the National Health Service Act 1977(2);

"the 1978 Act" means the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(3);

"the 1988 Act" means the Health and Medicines Act 1988.

Days appointed

- 2.—(1) 7th March 1989 is the day appointed for the coming into force of each provision of the 1988 Act specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order for the purposes specified in relation to it in column 3 of that Schedule.
 - (2) 1st April 1989 is the day appointed for the coming into force of
 - (a) each provision of the 1988 Act specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order for the purposes specified in relation to it in column 3 of that Schedule;
 - (b) section 25(2) of the 1988 Act (repeals) so far as it relates to
 - (i) sections 37(a), 78(1) and 79(1)(a) of, and Schedules 12 and 15 to, the 1977 Act,
