The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 33(3) of the Petroleum and Submarine Pipe-lines Act 1975(1) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after giving those persons affected an opportunity of being heard with respect to the matter, hereby makes the following Order:—

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the Submarine Pipe-lines (Designated Owners) (No. 12) Order 1989 and shall come into force on 12th June 1989.
- **2.** For the purposes of Part III of the Act, each person specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto is hereby designated as the owner of so much of the pipe-line specified in Part II of the Schedule hereto as is a controlled pipe-line.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates the companies listed in Part I of the Schedule as owners of that part of the pipe-line described in Part II of the Schedule which lies in controlled waters, that is, the territorial sea and areas designated under the Continental Shelf Act 1964 (c. 29). The pipe-line lies between the Thames gasfield, situated north-east of the Norfolk coast and the Phillips/ARCO British Terminal at Bacton in Norfolk.
