**The Court of Protection (Enduring Powers
of Attorney) (Amendment) Rules 1990**

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 106 of the Mental Health Act 1983⁽¹⁾ and with the consent of the Treasury so far as is required by subsection (5) of that section hereby makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Court of Protection (Enduring Powers of Attorney) (Amendment) Rules 1990 and shall come into force on 1st May 1990.
2. Column 2 of Schedule 2 to the Court of Protection (Enduring Powers of Attorney) Rules 1986⁽²⁾ shall be amended as follows:
 - (a) for the figure “£30.00” there shall be substituted the figure “£50.00”
 - (b) for the figure “£5.00” there shall be substituted the figure “£10.00”
