- 1. This Order may be cited as the Antarctic Treaty (Contracting Parties) Order 1990.
- **2.** It is hereby certified that the Contracting Parties for the purposes of the Antarctic Treaty Act 1967 areas specified in the Schedule to this Order.
 - 3. The Antarctic Treaty (Contracting Parties) Order 1988 (2) is hereby revoked.
