The Immigration (Variation of Leave) (No.2) Order 1991

Made - - - - *25th April 1991*

Coming into force - - *26th April 1991*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 3(3)(a) and 4(1) of the Immigration Act 1971(1), I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Variation of Leave)(No.2) Order 1991 and shall come into force on the day after the day on which it is made.

2. The condition imposed by article 2 of the Immigration (Variation of Leave) Order 1991(2) is hereby removed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order removes the condition imposed by the Immigration(Variation of Leave) Order 1991 (S.I.1991/77) (revoked by S.I.1991/980) which requires all Iraqi nationals who are not also either British citizens or persons exercising an enforceable Community right or rights under any provision made under section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 (c. 68) and who have a limited leave to enter or remain in the United Kingdom, to register with the police as a condition of that leave if such a requirement is not already such a condition.
