The Superannuation (Scottish Legal Services Ombudsman) Order 1991

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(5) of the Superannuation Act 1972⁽¹⁾ and now vested in them⁽²⁾, hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Scottish Legal Services Ombudsman) Order 1991 and shall come into force on 1st June 1991.
2. The office of the Scottish legal services ombudsman is hereby added to the offices listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation Act 1972.
3. Employment by the Scottish legal services ombudsman is hereby added to the employments listed in that Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order adds the office of the Scottish legal services ombudsman and the employment of his staff to the offices and employments listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation Act 1972 so that the Principal Civil Service Pension Scheme and the Civil Service Additional Voluntary Contribution Scheme made under section 1 of that Act may apply to them. Provision for the appointment of the Scottish legal services ombudsman and his staff was made by section 34 of the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1990 (c. 40) and Schedule 3 thereto.
