# The Superannuation (Scottish Legal Services Ombudsman) Order 1991

Made - - - - 9th May 1991
Laid before Parliament 10th May 1991
Coming into force - - 1st June 1991

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1(5) of the Superannuation Act 1972(1) and now vested in them(2), hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Superannuation (Scottish LegalServices Ombudsman) Order 1991 and shall come into force on 1st June1991.
- **2.** The office of the Scottish legal services ombudsman is hereby added to the offices listed in Schedule 1 to the Superannuation Act 1972.
- **3.** Employment by the Scottish legal services ombudsman is hereby added to the employments listed in that Schedule.
