Designation (KingdomCablevision Limited)  
(Glenrothes and Kirkcaldy) Order 1991**

Whereas the Secretary of State has granted to Kingdom Cablevision Limited on 18th April 1991 a Licence (“the Licence”) under section 7 of the Telecommunications Act 1984(1) (“the Act”), to which section 8 of the Act applies, for the running of the telecommunication systems specified in Annex A to the Licence (“the Applicable Cabled Systems”):

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:—

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Public Telecommunication System Designation (Kingdom Cablevision Limited) (Glenrothes and Kirkcaldy) Order 1991 and shall come into force on 12th June 1991.

**2.** Each of the Applicable Cabled Systems is hereby designated as a public telecommunication system.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

The Secretary of State granted to Kingdom Cablevision Limited a licence on 18th April 1991 under section 7 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 to run the telecommunication systems specified in Annex A to that licence, in the Glenrothes and Kirkcaldy area. A copy of the licence was laid before Parliament on 15th May 1991. This Order designates those telecommunication systems as public telecommunication systems. Consequently, by virtue of section 9(3) of that Act, Kingdom Cablevision Limited will be a public telecommunications operator in respect of its Glenrothes and Kirkcaldy public telecommunication systems when the Order comes into force on 12th June 1991.
