**The Financial Assistance (UK 2000  
Scotland) (Scotland) Order 1991**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 153(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, considering that UK 2000 Scotland is an organisation whose purposes relate to the protection, improvement or better understanding of the environment, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Financial Assistance (UK 2000 Scotland) (Scotland) Order 1991, shall come into force on 11th June 1991 and shall extend to Scotland only.

2. Section 153(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup> shall be varied by the addition of the following paragraph:

“(o) UK 2000 Scotland.”.
