The Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) Order 1991

Made - - - - 26th June 1991

Coming into force - - 1st August 1991

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 26th day of June 1991

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 13 of the Child Abduction and Custody Act 1985(1), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) Order 1991 and shall come into force on 1st August 1991.

(2) The Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) Order 1990(2) is revoked.

2. For Schedule 2 to the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) Order 1986(3) there shall be substituted the following—

(2) S.I.1990/2289.
(3) S.I. 1986/1159.
