**The Immigration Appeals (Procedure) (Amendment) Rules 1991**

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 22 of, and paragraph 25 of Schedule 2 to, the Immigration Act 1971<sup>(1)</sup>, and now vested in him<sup>(2)</sup>, hereby makes the following Rules:—

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules may be cited as the Immigration Appeals (Procedure) (Amendment) Rules 1991 and shall come into force on 31st October 1991.

**Amendment of Immigration Appeals (Procedure) Rules 1984(3)**

2. In rule 27 of the Immigration Appeals (Procedure) Rules 1984, for “10 miles” there shall be substituted “16 kilometres”.
