**The Occupational Pension Schemes
(Preservation of Benefit) Regulations 1991**

Deductions from short service benefit

20.—(1) This regulation applies where a scheme provides that, in computing the amount of long service benefit payable to any person, a deduction will be made, either to take account of benefits payable to that person under the ^{M1} Social Security Act 1975 or otherwise.

(2) Where this regulation applies, the scheme may provide for a corresponding deduction from short service benefit.^{F1}...
