## The Occupational Pension Schemes (Preservation of Benefit) Regulations 1991

### Deductions from short service benefit

**20.**—(1) This regulation applies where a scheme provides that, in computing the amount of long service benefit payable to any person, a deduction will be made, either to take account of benefits payable to that person under the <sup>M1</sup> Social Security Act 1975 or otherwise.

(2) Where this regulation applies, the scheme may provide for a corresponding deduction from short service benefit.<sup>F1</sup>...
