**The Health Education Authority (Establishment
and Constitution) Amendment Order 1991**

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of powers conferred by section 11 of and paragraph 9(7)(b) of Schedule 5 to the National Health Service Act 1977(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Health Education Authority (Establishment and Constitution) Amendment Order 1991 and shall come into force on 11th March 1991.

Amendment of Order

2.—(1) The Health Education Authority (Establishment and Constitution) Order 1987(2) shall be amended in accordance with the following provisions of this article.

(2) After article 4 there shall be added the following article—

“Remuneration of members

5. The Authority is specified for the purposes of paragraph 9(7)(b) of Schedule 5 to the National Health Service Act 1977.”.
