- **1.** This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Distress Signalsand Prevention of Collisions) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order 1991 and shall come into force on 19th April 1991.
- **2.** Article 3 of the Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention Collisions) (Guernsey) Order 1989(2) shall be amended by the insertion, after "Regulations 1989", of as amended by the Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention Collisions) (Amendment) Regulations 1991"(3).
