The King's Lynn-Newark Trunk Road (Leadenham By-Pass and Slip Roads) (Revocation) Order 1991

Made - - - - - *20th March 1991*
Coming into force - - - - - *4th April 1991*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Highways Act 1980⁽¹⁾, and now vested in him⁽²⁾, and of all other enabling powers:

1. The King's Lynn-Newark Trunk Road (Leadenham By-Pass and Slip Roads) Order 1973⁽³⁾ is hereby revoked.
2. This Order shall come into force on 4th April 1991 and may be cited as the King's Lynn-Newark Trunk Road (Leadenham By-Pass and Slip Roads) (Revocation) Order 1991.
