**The Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland)  
Act 1990 (Commencement No. 5) Order 1991**

*Made - - - - 28th March 1991*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 75(2) of the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1990<sup>(1)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation**

1. This Order may be cited as the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1990 (Commencement No. 5) Order 1991.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order—

“the Act” means the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1990.

**Commencement**

3. The provisions of the Act which are specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, and described by reference to subject matters in column 2 of that Schedule, shall, in so far as they are not then in force, come into force on 1st April 1991.
