## **IMMIGRATION**

The Immigration (Registration with Police) (Amendment) Regulations 1991

Made - - - - 8th April 1991
Laid before Parliament 16th April 1991
Coming into force - - 1st June 1991

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4(3) of the Immigration Act 1971(1), I hereby make the following Regulations:

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Registration with Police) (Amendment) Regulations 1991 and shall come into force on 1st June 1991.
- **2.** In regulation 10(3) of the Immigration (Registration with Police) Regulations 1972(**2**) (which relates to the fee to be paid for the issue of registration certificates), for the figure "£36" there shall be substituted the figure "£27.50".

These Regulations reduce the fee payable when aliens are required to register with the police from £36 to £27.50. This reduction reflects a recent reassessment of the cost of the issue of registration certificates.
