IMMIGRATION

The Immigration (Variation of Leave) (Revocation) Order 1991

Made - - - - 12th April 1991

Coming into force in accordance with article 1

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 3(3)(a) and 4(1) of the Immigration Act 1971⁽¹⁾, I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Variation of Leave)(Revocation) Order 1991 and shall come into force on the day after the day on which it is made.
2. The Immigration (Variation of Leave) Order 1991⁽²⁾ is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order revokes the Immigration (Variation of Leave) Order 1991(S.I.1991/77) which requires all Iraqi nationals who are not also either British citizens or persons exercising an enforceable Community right or rights under any provision made under section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 (c. 68) and who have a limited leave to enter or remain in the United Kingdom to register with the police as a condition of that leave if such a requirement is not already such a condition.
