The Portsmouth Mile End Quay Harbour Revision Order 1991

Limits of Harbour Master's Jurisdiction

9.—(1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this Article, the limits within which the powers of the Harbour Master of the Council may be exercised under and subject to the provisions of the Act of 1847 as incorporated with this Order, and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, shall extend:

- (a) to a distance of 100 metres in every direction from the works from time to time comprising the Mile End Quay undertaking; and
- (b) to so much of the dredged channels provided for access to those works and for accommodation of vessels at those works under Article 12 (Power to Dredge, etc) of this Order as extend beyond 100 metres from those works.

(2) The powers exercisable by virtue of this article shall be limited to vessels going to, moored at, or departing from Mile End Quay.

(3) Subject to the provisions of Article 3 of this Order section 52 of the Act 1847 in its application to the Council and the Harbour Master shall extend to empower the Harbour Master to give directions prohibiting the mooring of vessels in or near to any approach to the works.

(4) In case of conflict between any directions given by the Harbour Master of the Council and any directions given by the person for the time being appointed to be the Queen's Harbour Master of the Dockyard Port of Portsmouth under the Dockyard Ports Regulation Act 1865(1), the directions given by the Queen's Harbour Master shall prevail.
