**The Immigration (Registration with
Police) (Amendment) Regulations 1992**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 4(3) of the Immigration Act 1971⁽¹⁾, I hereby make the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Registration with Police) (Amendment) Regulations 1992 and shall come into force on 20th July 1992.

2. In Regulation 10(3) of the Immigration (Registration with Police) Regulations 1972⁽²⁾ (which relates to the fee paid for the issue of registration certificates), for the figure “ £27.50” there shall be substituted the figure “£30”.
