**The Army, Air Force and Naval Discipline  
Acts (Continuation) Order 1992**

*Made* - - - - *15th July 1992*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 15th day of July 1992

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 1(2) of the Armed Forces Act 1991<sup>(1)</sup>, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

**1.** The Army Act 1955<sup>(2)</sup>, the Air Force Act 1955<sup>(3)</sup> and the Naval Discipline Act 1957<sup>(4)</sup> shall continue in force for a period of twelve months beyond 31st August 1992, that day being the day on which they would otherwise expire.

**2.** This Order may be cited as the Army, Air Force and Naval Discipline Acts (Continuation) Order 1992.
