**The Indictments (Procedure) (Amendment) Rules 1992**

*Made - - - - 5th September 1992*

*Coming into force - - 1st October 1992*

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 2(6) of the Administration of Justice (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1933<sup>(1)</sup>, hereby makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the Indictments (Procedure)(Amendment) Rules 1992 and shall come into force on 1st October 1992.

2. After rule 5(1)(b) of the Indictments (Procedure) Rules 1971<sup>(2)</sup> there shall be inserted the following:

“(c) where a notice of transfer has been served under section 53 of the Criminal Justice Act 1991<sup>(3)</sup> (notices of transfer in certain cases involving children), within a period of 28 days commencing with the date on which notice is served.”.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

These Rules provide that where notice of transfer is served under section 53 of the Criminal Justice Act 1991 the period within which a bill of indictment is to be preferred shall be a period of 28 days beginning on the date on which notice of transfer is served on the magistrates' court.
