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## SCHEDULE 3

## INFLATED BOATS

## Construction

- **2.18** A boat shall be constructed in such a way that, when suspended by its bridle or lifting hook:
- (2.18.1) it is of sufficient strength and rigidity to enable it to be lowered and recovered with all its equipment and a crew of two persons;
- (2.18.2) it is of sufficient strength to withstand a load of 1.1 times the mass of its equipment and a crew of two persons at an ambient temperature of  $-30^{\circ}$ C with relief valves operative; and
- (2.18.3) it is of sufficient strength to withstand a load of 4 times the mass of its equipment and a crew of two persons at an ambient temperature of  $20 \pm 3$ °C with all relief valves inoperative.
