The Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) (No. 5) Order 1992

Made - - - - *17th December 1992*
Coming into force - - *1st February 1993*

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 17th day of December 1992

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by section 2 of the Child Abduction and Custody Act 1985(1), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) (No. 5) Order 1992 and shall come into force on 1st February 1993.

(2) The Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order 1992(2) is revoked.

2. For Schedule 1 to the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) Order 1986(3) there shall be substituted the following—
