## SCHEDULE 7

## RESTRICTIONS BY THE UK AUTHORITY

## Appeals

- 5.—(1) Section 46 of the Building Societies Act (rights of appeal) shall have effect as if—
  - (a) the decisions mentioned in subsection (1) included a decision of the Commission to impose or vary a restriction; and
  - (b) in relation to such a decision, the reference in that subsection to a building society included a reference to a UK subsidiary.

(2) Section 47 of that Act(1) (determination of appeals) shall have effect as if it included provision enabling the tribunal to vary any decision of the Commission to impose or vary a restriction by directing the Commission to impose a different restriction or make a different variation.
