In exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the Education (Student Loans) Act 1990(1), the Secretary of State for Education hereby makes the following Regulations:

### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Student Loans) (Amendment) Regulations 1993 and shall come into force on 1st August 1993.

#### **Amendment of 1993 Regulations**

**2.** For regulation 11(6) of the Education (Student Loans) Regulations 1993(2) there is substituted—

"(6) In paragraph (5) "disability-related benefits" means—

(a) the benefits or allowances payable pursuant to the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992(3) known as invalidity benefit(4), severe disablement allowance(5), disability living allowance(6) and industrial injuries benefit(7);

- (b) disability premium and severe disability premium payable pursuant to the Income Support (General) Regulations 1987(8); and
- (c) disability working allowance payable under sections 123(1)(c) and 129 of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992.".
