## schedule 1

routes of the first new trunk road andthe second new trunk road

The routes of the first new trunk road and the second new trunk road are in the Borough of Restormel in the County of Cornwall and are:—

- 1. The first new trunk road, between Penhale and Indian Queens, is about 4.76 kilometres in length, commencing from a point on the A30 approximately 115 metres east of its junction with the C185 road to St Enoder and proceeding in a north-easterly direction to a point on the A30 approximately 10 metres east of its junction with the unclassified road to Ruthvoes.
- 2. The second new trunk road, between Indian Queens and Black Cross, is about 3.46 kilometres in length, commencing with a roundabout under the first new trunk road (the centre point of that roundabout being approximately 300 metres south of the boundary of the A30 and south-east of the cemetery) and proceeding north-westwards to a point on the A39 approximately 115 metres north of its junction with the C376 road to Newquay, at Black Cross. This route comprises a roundabout, at Trevarren, connecting with the A39 and a new highway (linking with the A392 road to Newquay) which is to be constructed by the Secretary of State pursuant to the side roads Order.
