The Assisted Areas (Amendment) Order 1993

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 1(1), (3), (4) and (7) of the Industrial Development Act 1982(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Assisted Areas (Amendment) Order 1993 and shall come into force on 1st August 1993.
2. The Assisted Areas Order 1993(2) shall be amended by substituting “5th April 1981” for “2nd April 1988” in article 2(2)(2).
