**EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES**

**The Education (Teachers) (Amendment) Regulations 1993**

*Made* - - - - *2nd August 1993*  
*Laid before Parliament* *5th August 1993*  
*Coming into force* - - *1st September 1993*

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 218(1)(a), (2) and 232(5) of the Education Reform Act 1988(1), the Secretary of State for Education hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Teachers) (Amendment) Regulations 1993 and shall come into force on 1st September 1993.

**Amendment**

2. In paragraph 2 of Schedule 3 to the Education (Teachers) Regulations 1993(2)—
- (a) in sub-paragraph (1), for the words “institution or university” there shall be substituted the words “school, city technology college, institution, or university”;
  - (b) for sub-paragraph (1)(a), there shall be substituted the following—
    - “(i) is for the degree of Bachelor of Education, a certificate in Education, a post-graduate certificate in Education or a comparable qualification awarded by a university in England or Wales; or
    - (ii) is a post-graduate course of teacher training at a school or city technology college”.
