The Non-Domestic Rating (Demand Notices) (Wales) Regulations 1993

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations—

“the 1988 Act” means the Local Government Finance Act 1988;

“the 1992 Act” means the Local Government Finance Act 1992;

“the Collection Regulations” means the Non-Domestic Rating (Collection and Enforcement) (Local Lists) Regulations 1989⁽¹⁾;

“billing authority” means a Welsh billing authority;

“demand notice” means a demand notice within the meaning of Part II of the Collection Regulations which is served by a billing authority (including such a notice served pursuant to Part II of the Non-Domestic Rating (Collection and Enforcement) (Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 1990⁽²⁾ (joint owners and occupiers));

“local precepting authority”, in relation to a billing authority, means a community council which has power to issue a precept to the billing authority;

“the major precepting authority”, in relation to a billing authority, means the county council which has power to issue a precept to the billing authority; and

“the relevant year” in relation to a demand notice, means the financial year to which the demand for payment made by the notice relates.
