**The Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988  
(Firearms Consultative Committee) Order 1993**

*Made - - - - 27th November 1993*

In exercise of the power conferred on me by section 22(8) of the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988<sup>(1)</sup>, I hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988 (Firearms Consultative Committee) Order 1993.
2. The Firearms Consultative Committee shall, following the expiry of the initial period of its existence specified in section 22(8) of the Firearms (Amendment) Act 1988, continue to exist for a period of three years beginning on 1st February 1994.
