COMMON AGRICULTURAL POLICY

The Organic Products (Amendment) Regulations 1993

Made - - - - *25th February 1993*
Laid before Parliament *8th March 1993*
Coming into force - - *29th March 1993*

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, being Ministers designated⁽¹⁾ for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972⁽²⁾ in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Economic Community, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the said section 2(2), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:—

Title and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Organic Products (Amendment) Regulations 1993 and shall come into force on 29th March 1993.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations “the principal Regulations” means the Organic Products Regulations 1992⁽³⁾.

Amendment of the principal Regulations

3. In regulation 7 paragraphs (1) and (2) respectively, for the words “a Specified Community provision” there shall be substituted “regulation 6(2) above”.
