MEMBERSHIP OF THE UNIVERSITY COURT

Age limit for governors

12. A person who has attained the age of 70 years shall not thereafter be eligible to take office: Provided that nothing in this article shall prohibit a person who attains the said age during a term of office as a governor from continuing as a governor until the expiry of that term.
