BANKS AND BANKING

The Banking Act 1987 (Exempt Persons) Order 1993

Made - - - - - *30th March 1993*
Laid before Parliament *2nd April 1993*
Coming into force - - *23rd April 1993*

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 4(3) of the Banking Act 1987⁽¹⁾ and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and after consultation with the Bank of England, hereby order as follows:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Banking Act 1987 (Exempt Persons) Order 1993 and shall come into force on 23rd April 1993.

Exemption

2. Schedule 2 to the Banking Act 1987 shall be amended by the addition of the following new entry after the entry numbered 26—

“27. The Council of Europe Resettlement Fund.”.
