## **BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES**

The Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Amendment) Regulations 1993

Made	31st April 1993
Laid before Parliament	2nd April 1993
Coming into force	1st May 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 14(2) and 51 of the Gaming Act 1968(1), and after consultation with the Gaming Board for Great Britain, I hereby make the following Regulations:

**1.**—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Amendment) Regulations 1993 and shall come into force on 1st May 1993.

(2) These Regulations do not extend to Scotland.

**2.** Regulation 5(1) of the Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) Regulations 1984(**2**), shall be amended by substituting for the figure "£6.20", in both places where it occurs, the figure "£6.40".

3. The Gaming Clubs (Hours and Charges) (Amendment) Regulations 1992(3), are hereby revoked.
