**The Education (Writtle Agricultural College  
Further Education Corporation) (Transfer  
to the Higher Education Sector) Order 1994**

Whereas it appears to the Secretary of State that the full-time equivalent enrolment number of the institution conducted by Writtle Agricultural College Further Education Corporation<sup>(1)</sup> for courses of higher education exceeds 55 per cent of its total full-time equivalent enrolment number;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for Education, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 122A of the Education Reform Act 1988 <sup>(2)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Education (Writtle Agricultural College Further Education Corporation) (Transfer to the Higher Education Sector) Order 1994 and shall come into force on 1st October 1994.

**2.** On the date on which this Order comes into force Writtle Agricultural College Further Education Corporation shall cease to be a further education corporation and shall become a higher education corporation.
