## **CUSTOMS AND EXCISE**

The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994 (Amendment No. 2) Order 1994

Made - - - - 24th September 1994

Coming into force - - 24th September 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(1) and now vested in him(2), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994 (Amendment No. 2) Order 1994 and shall come into force on 24th September 1994.
  - 2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1994(3) shall be further amended as follows:—
    in entries 9A990 and 9E990 in Group 3 of Part III of Schedule 1, for "Libya, Iran, Iraq or Syria." there shall be substituted "Libya, Iran or Iraq.".
