The A630 Trunk Road (Doncaster) (Detrunking) Order 1994

Made - - - - *20th December 1994*

Coming into force - - *1st February 1995*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980(1), and now vested in him(2), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf:—

1. This Order may be cited as the A630 Trunk Road (Doncaster) (Detrunking) Order 1994 and shall come into force on 1st February 1995.

2. In this Order—

(i) “principal road” as a classification for a highway, means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of enactments and instruments which refer to highways classified as principal roads and is also classified for the purpose of every other enactment and instrument which refers to highways classified by the Secretary of State; and

(ii) “the trunk road” means the A630 Trunk Road.

3. The length of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road from the date on which this order comes into force.

THE SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF THE TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

The length of the trunk road ceasing to be a trunk road is situated between the former Doncaster County Borough boundary at Warmsworth (marked A on the deposited plan) to the boundary of Doncaster Metropolitan Borough and Rotherham Metropolitan District, Hilltop, Conisbrough (marked B on the deposited plan) a distance of approximately 6.91 kilometres and is shown by broad black dashes on the plan numbered HA10/YHNMD/9 marked “The A630 Trunk Road (Doncaster) (Detrunking) Order 1994”, signed by authority of the Secretary of State for Transport and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, 43 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY.
